Activities in the week commencing 20 February 2017 (3.30pm to 4.30pm)

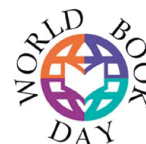
- Monday** Netball Club for Years 3 to 6, there is no charge for this. Taken by Gemma Cole.
